



SAP (System Application and Product)

The SAP competition is a challenge for students using a simulation designed so that a student with few ERP/SAP skills can succeed although there are suggested resources available below, under 'Resources'.

The software used for this contest is ScrimmageSIM.

This competition is a progressive set of tasks to be completed by teams of 1-2 students.

Contest Note: students must be capable of saving their submissions on a USB flash drive from their personal computers.

Team Composition

Individuals or teams of 2 students can register for this competition.

Skills

Previous ERP/SAP skills will be helpful, but are not required for this competition. A motivated student with no prior experience can do well in this contest although reading about ScrimmageSIM is strongly suggested. The main skills for Students wishing to be successful is that they have an inquisitive nature and a drive to succeed.

Scoring

Points will be given for successful and correct completion of challenges. In case of a tie, the winners' partial, incomplete, or incorrect submissions will be analyzed and partial points will be given for attempted but incorrect challenges. Grading will be done by a judge with experience grading the ScrimmageSIM challenge.

In the event of multiple students completing the entire contest 100% correctly, the student to complete the contest first will be given first place.
